Glancing Back

Central Otago Boutique Wineries Presenter: Neil Hickling of Co-Pilot Distributors.

The tasting included wines from 3 small Central Otago producers.

Locharburn Estate provided;

Locharburn Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2010 Locharburn Pinot Noir 2008

Alexandra Wine Company provided;

Alex Wine Co Chardonnay 2007 Alex Wine Co Davishon Pinot Noir 2007.

Domain Road Vineyard provided;

as a starter their Domain Road Dry Riesling 2010 Domain Road Pinot Gris 2010 Domain Road Pinot Noir 2008

And to round it all off there was a Forrest Estate 2009 "Tatty Bogler" Pinot Gris. For those who do not know, Tatty Bogler is the name Forrest use for wines made from grapes sourced in Central Otago.

Rather than speak a great deal about the wines, Neil preferred a less formal approach and generally just circulated during the tasting discussing the wines with individual groups, not the whole meeting. This approach did allow for a more relaxed tasting and for greater discussion at the tables but did mean that there was some lack of structure to the meeting. Not a format I personally would like to see as a regular feature though it does work on the odd occasion.

The gaps were filled to some extent by a discussion on some of the wines by Derek Thompson and Mark Haythornthwaite. Mark also gave an interesting backgrounder on Pinot Noir in Martinborough and also lead a short discussion on "screw caps" which can lead to hints of sulphur in some wines at first opening. He has a preference to return to corks for his own wines.
